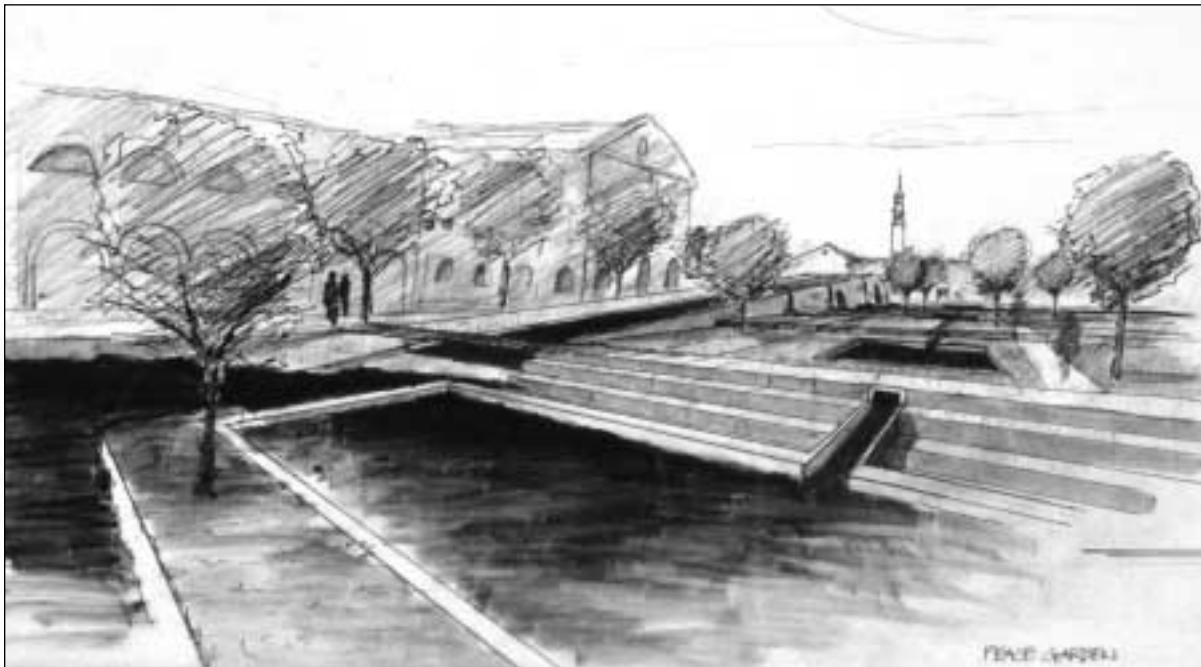
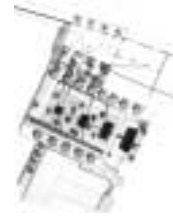


## A MEMORIAL PEACE GARDEN FOR THE ARSENALE

This project involved the creation of a master plan for the Arsenale, which would accommodate tourist functions such as a naval museum and civic and private functions that would make it a living breathing part of Venice. These images are of my proposal for a memorial peace garden for one of its spaces. In this design, I used water, existing ship building ramps, reflecting pools and plantings, to create a contemplative setting. These elements became a metaphor used to represent both ideas about struggle and resolution, as well as making evident the processes that sustain life in the Venice Lagoon.
